

How to Enable Pop-ups in Browsers

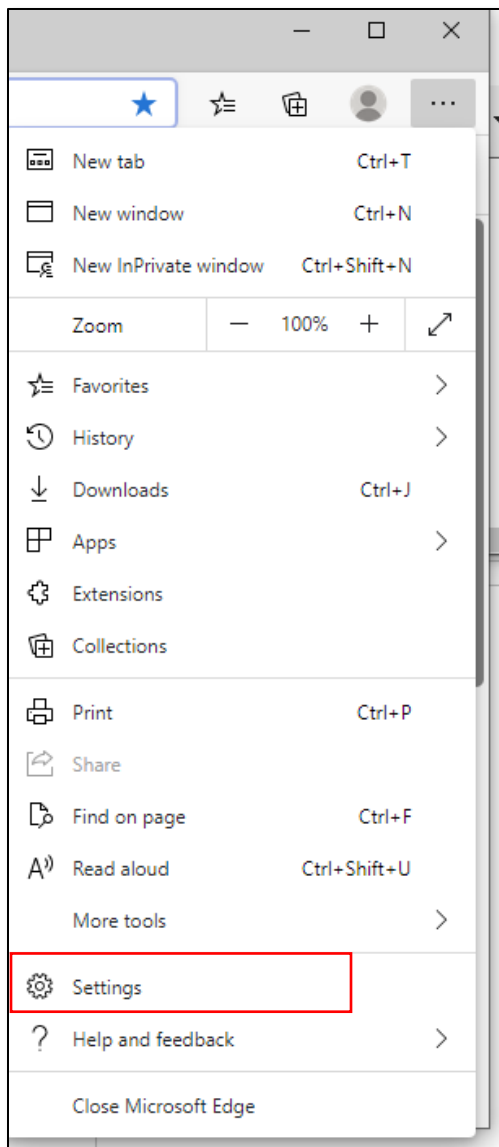
Pop-ups may need to be enabled in order to view the courseware or to fully access screen interactions.

Microsoft Edge (v87)

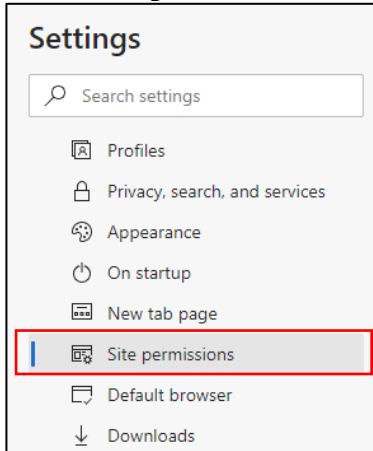
1. Open the **Microsoft Edge** browser.
2. Select the three horizontal dots at the top right of the browser to open the **Menu**.



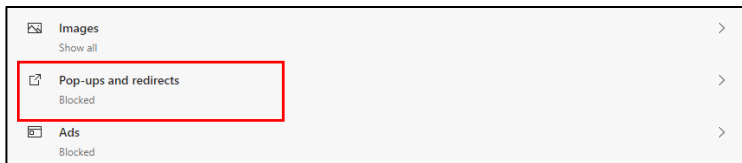
3. Scroll down to select **Settings** from the list.



4. Select **Site permissions** from the list provided.



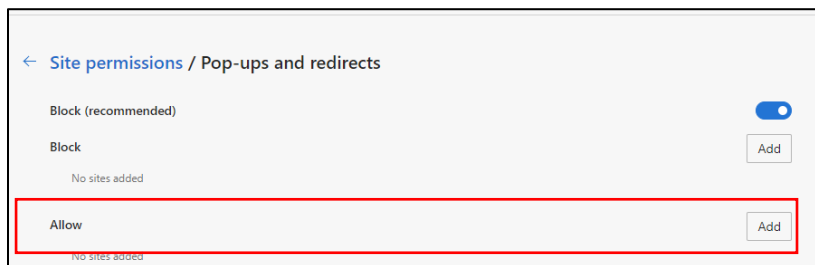
5. Scroll down the list and locate **Pop-ups and redirects**. Select the arrow to the right of this option.



6. If pop-ups are blocked, toggle the button to to the left to turn pop-up blocking off.



Note: You may add the CDSE STEPP website address under Allow to always allow pop-ups from this site and leave other sites blocked.

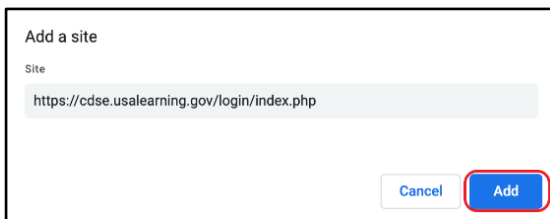


To add CDSE STEPP to the allowed sites:

- a. Select the **Add** button next to “Allow.”

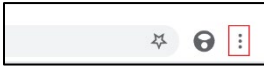


- b. Add the CDSE STEPP website (<https://cdse.usalearning.gov/>) to “Add a site”.
- c. Select the **Add** button.

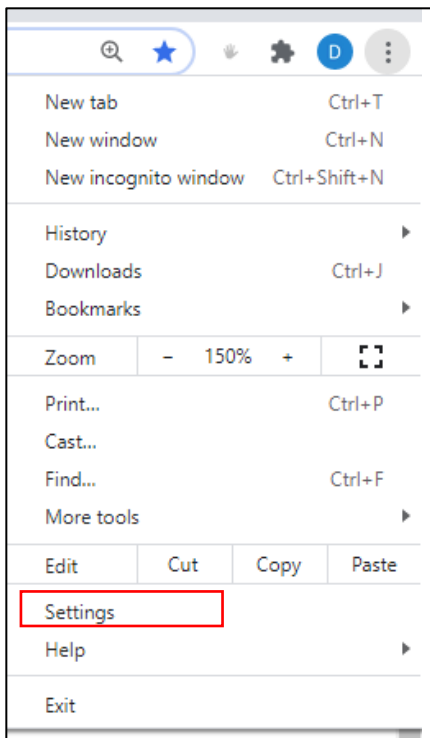


Chrome (v88)

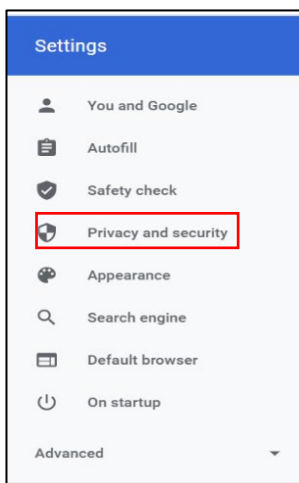
1. Open the **Chrome** browser.
2. Select the three vertical dots at the top right of the browser to open the **Menu**.



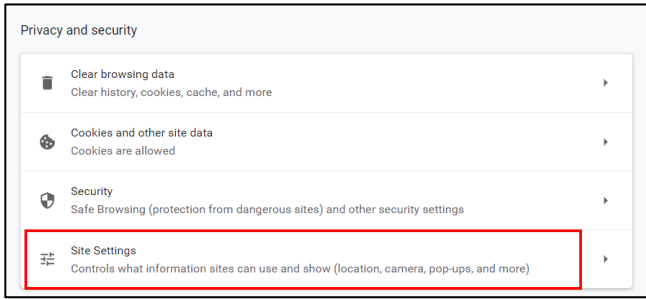
3. Select **Settings**.



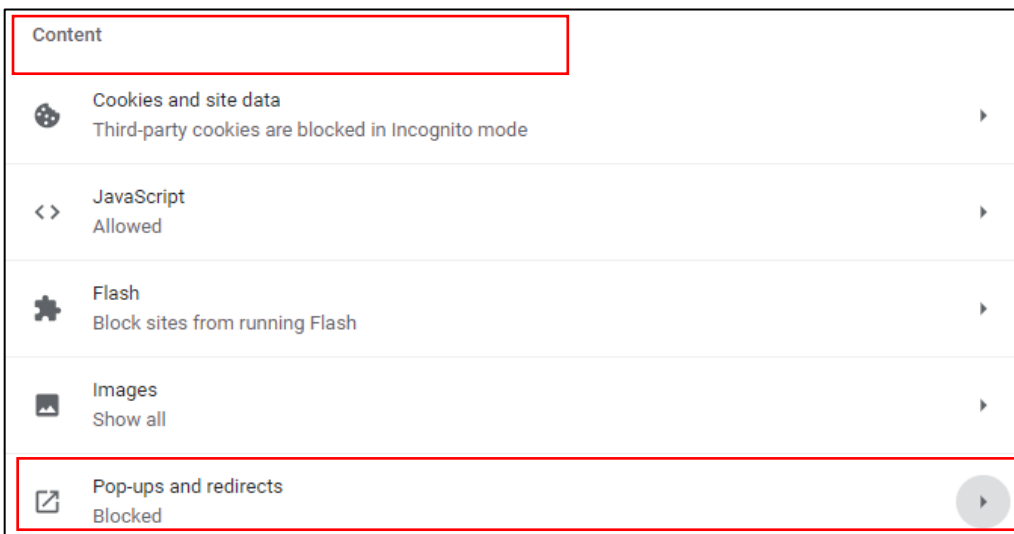
4. Select **Privacy and security**.



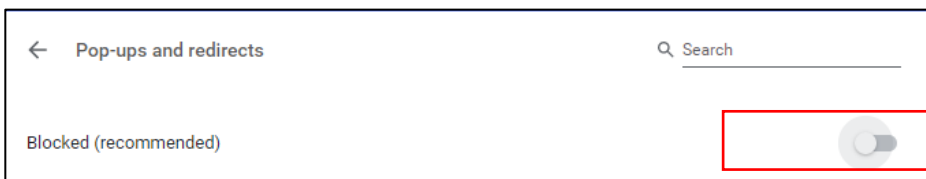
5. Select **Site Settings**.



6. Scroll down the page and locate **Content**. Select the **Pop-ups and redirects** to open pop-up setting options.



The pop-up option displays.



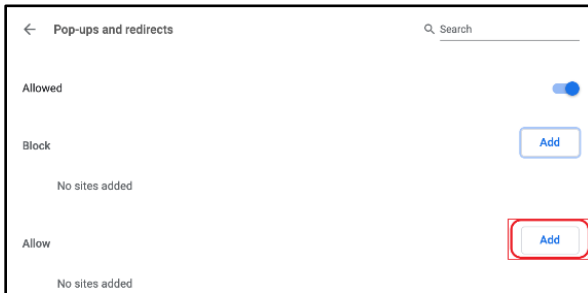
7. Toggle the button to **Allowed**.



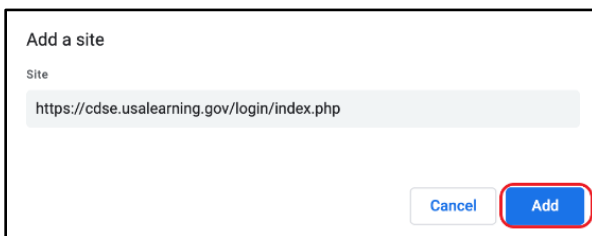
Note: You may add the CDSE STEPP website address under Allow to always allow pop-ups from this site and leave other sites blocked.

To add CDSE STEPP to allow the sites:

- a. Select the **Add** button next to “Allow”.



- b. Add the CDSE STEPP website (<https://cdse.usalearning.gov/>) to “Add a site”.
- c. Select the **Add** button.

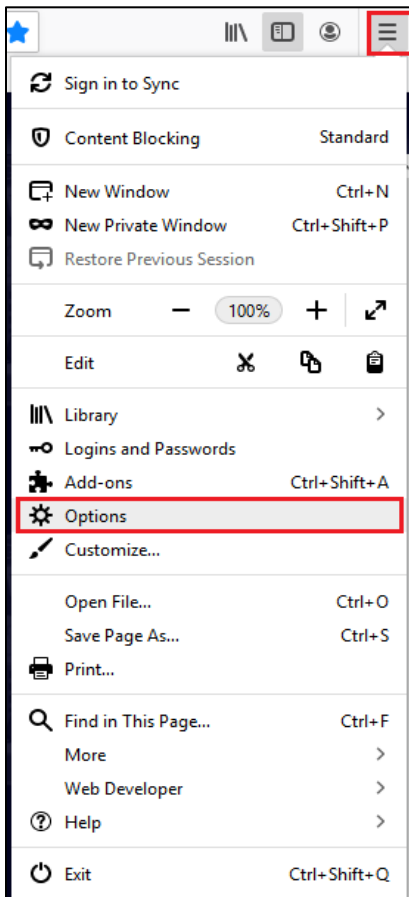


Firefox (v85)

1. Open the **Firefox** browser.
2. Select the three horizontal lines at the top right of the browser to open the **Menu**.



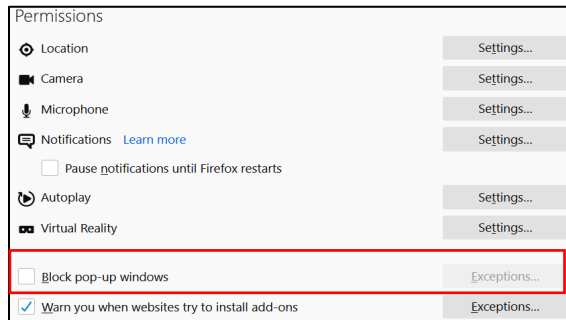
3. Select **Options** (looks like a gear).



4. Select **Privacy & Security** from the left panel.



5. Scroll down to the **Permissions** section. Remove the check mark from the **Block pop-up windows** option (if selected).

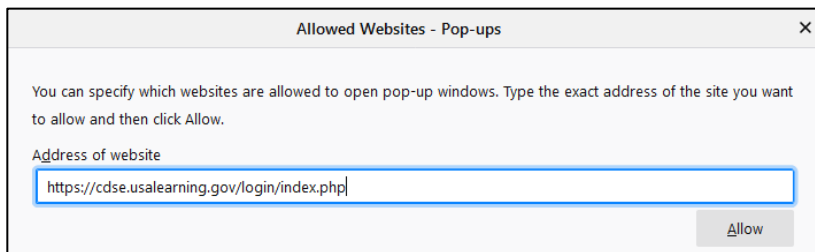


You may choose to leave pop-ups blocked and add the CDSE website as an exception.

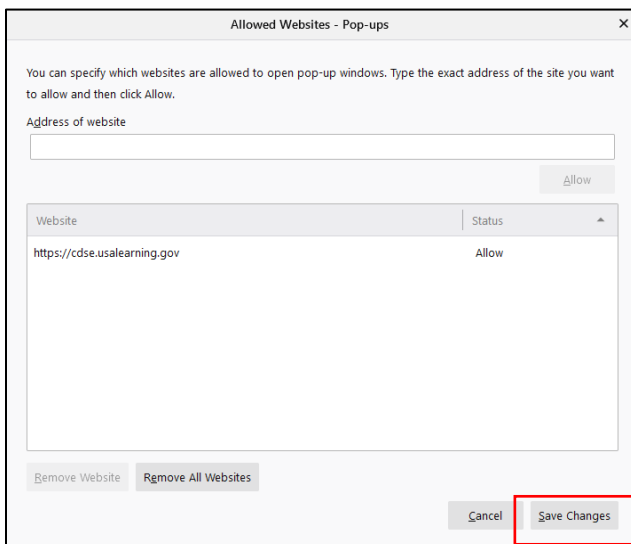
- a. Select the Exceptions button. A new window displays allowing you to type the website address that you want to be an exception for blocked pop-ups.



- b. Add the CDSE STEPP website (<https://cdse.usalearning.gov/>) to “Address of website” and select the **Allow** button.



- c. The website for which you have added an exception displays in the Website box with a status of “Allow.” Select the Save Changes button.

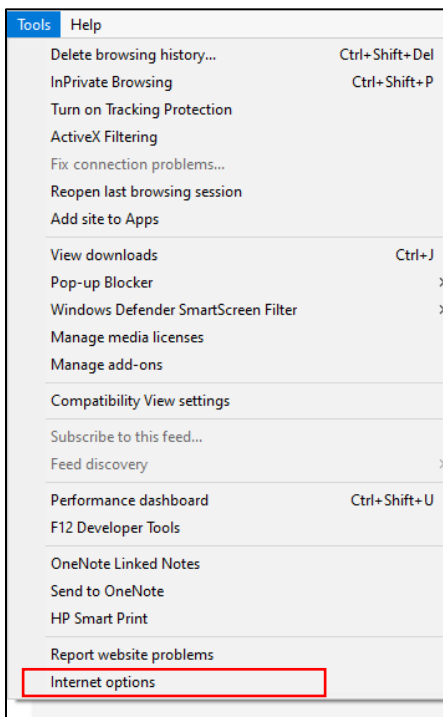


Internet Explorer 11

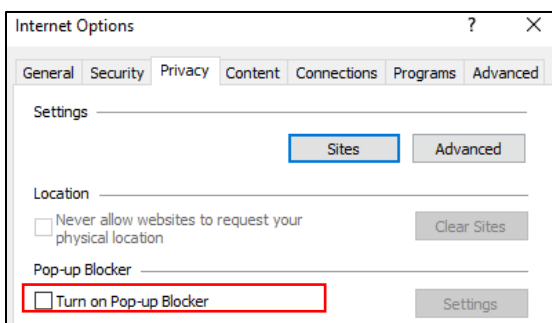
1. Open the **Internet Explorer** browser.
2. Select **Tools** from the menu bar (or select the 'gear' from the upper-left corner if your menu bar is not visible).



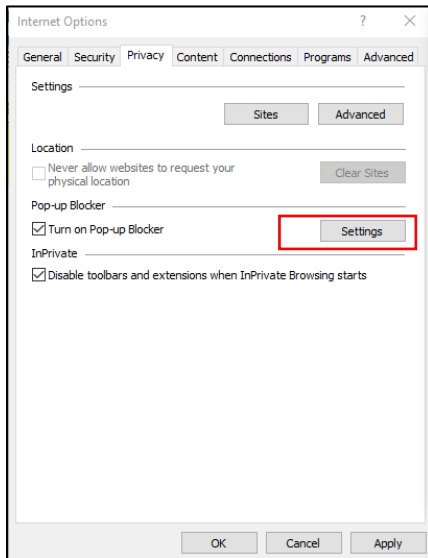
3. Select **Internet Options** from the list provided.



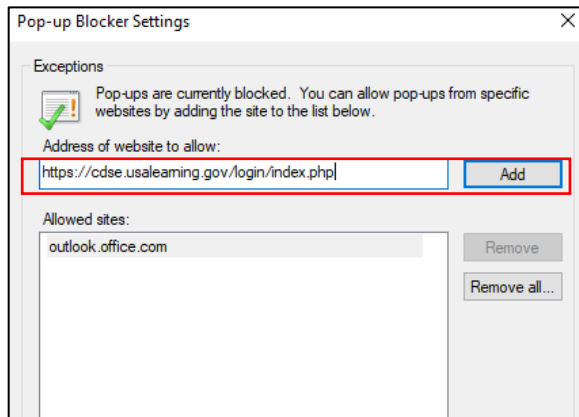
4. Select the **Privacy** tab.
 - a. Remove the check mark from the **Turn on Pop-up Blocker** box to allow pop-ups from all websites.



5. You may also designate a trusted website from which you will allow pop-ups.
 - a. To designate a trusted website, leave the check mark in the Turn on Pop-up Blocker box and select the Settings button.



- b. Type the address of the trusted website into the Address of website to allow field and select the Add button.



- c. The website added now appears in the “Allowed sites” field. You will only receive pop-ups from sites displaying in this field.
